## **STUDENTS SATISFACTION SURVEY 2020-2021**

### Introduction:

From 2017 onwards, the NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council) has endeavored to conduct a students' experience survey the result of which will go into the accreditation process. As per the direction given by the NAAC, institute conducted students' satisfaction survey for the session 2020-2021.

### Conclusions:

The detailed of the survey is as below:

- In 2020-21, those students whose involved in this survey, out of them, 35.30 % students answers this survey first and only one time. Maximum students i.e. 64.70 % involved in second time.
- Out of total 229 admitted students, 60 students given their responses for this survey. Out of these 68 students, according to data, 49 (70.05%) between the age of 17 to 20 years and 19 (27.95%) between the age of 21 to 24 years.
- All respondents are belonging to BPNISW only.
- Out of 68, 48 (70.58%) are Female students and 20 (29.42) are male students involved in the survey..
- In all respondents, currently, 42 (61.76%) pursuing Bachelor Degree Programme (BSW) and 26(38.24%) perusing master Degree Programme (MSW).
- All the respondents currently pursuing in social work subject area which belongs to humanities faculty.
- According to data most of the students i.e. 85.29 % opinioned that faculty of the institute covered the syllabi between 84 to 100 percent during the session, remaining 14.71 % said that, near about 54 to 69 percent syllabus covered by the faculty.
- Regarding the preparation for the classes, according to data, 41.17 % students opinioned that, teachers thoroughly prepared for the class and 58.83% said that, they are satisfied regarding teachers preparation.
- According to data, 54.41% students opinioned that, teachers had always able to communicate effectively, while 08.83% opinioned that, teachers are sometime communicate effectively with the students, 36.76% opinioned that they are just satisfied regarding the teachers communication in the class.
- Opinion on teacher's approach to teaching can best be described; 98.73% students opinioned that, their approach could be excellent and very good while 1.47% said that, teachers' approach regarding teaching could be fair.
- Opinion on Fairness of Internal Evaluation Process by the teachers, 72.05% students opinioned that fairness of the internal evaluation by the teachers are always and usually fair, 20.60 % students opinioned that, their approach regarding fairness of internal evaluation are sometime unfair and 07.35% students opinioned that, their approach is usually unfair.

- 47.05% students opined that, on students' Performance in Assignment Discussed with students every time while 30.90% students opined that, teachers discussed with students regarding their performance in assignment usually and 22.05% said that, teachers discussed with them on assignment performance sometimes or occasionally.
- 73.52 % students opined that, our institute takes Active interest in promoting Internship students exchange or field visits opportunities regularly, 17.66 said often while 07.35 said sometime and 01.47 opined rarely.
- Opinion on Teaching and Monitoring Process of the Institute—Facilitates the students in Cognitive, Social & Emotional Growth, 19.11% Opined that significantly, 48.54% said that very well and 32.35% opined that, moderately
- Opinion on Institute provides multiple opportunities to Learn & Growth, 42.65% said strongly agree, 50% opined Agree, 04.41% stick on neutral opinion and 02.94% are disagree with the opinion.
- Opinion on Teachers Informs to students about Expected Competencies & Programme Outcomes, 29.41% opined Every Time 54.41% said Usually, 14.71% opined Occasionally/Sometimes and 01.47% opined Rarely.
- 54.41% students Opined that, Mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assign task with students every time, 29.42% students opined that, Mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assign task with students usually, 13.23% students opined that, Mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assign task with students occasionally or sometime and only 02.94 % said that, Mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assign task with students rarely,
- 54.41% students opined that, our Teachers Illustrate the concepts through examples & applications every Time, 27.95 % students opined that, our Teachers Illustrate the concepts through examples & applications usually, 16.17 % students opined that, our Teachers Illustrate the concepts through examples & applications occasionally or sometime and only 01.47 % students opined that, our Teachers Illustrate the concepts through examples & applications very rarely.
- 41.17 % students opined that, on teachers identify students' strength and encourage the students With providing right level of Challenges every time and 58.83 % students opined that, on teachers identify students' strength and encourage the students With providing right level of Challenges usually.
- 33.82 % students opined that, on teachers is able to identify students' weaknesses & Help students to overcome them every time, 47.07 % students opined that, on teachers is able to identify students' weaknesses & Help students to overcome them usually, 16.17 % students opined that, on teachers is able to identify students' weaknesses & Help students to overcome them occasionally or some time and 02.94 % students opined that, on teachers is able to identify students' weaknesses & Help students to overcome them rarely.
- According to data, 17.65 % students has been strongly agree with that, teachers are discussed the Performance in Assignment with students, 60.29 % students agreed that, teachers are discussed the Performance in Assignment with students, 17.65 % students stick on neutral opinion and 04.41% are disagree with the opinion that, teachers are discussed the Performance in Assignment with students,
- 27.95 % students said that, the institute or Teachers use Student Centric Method (Experimental Learning, Participative Learning Problem Solving Method) to a great extent, 52.95 % students opined that, the institute or Teachers use Student Centric

Method (Experimental Learning, Participative Learning Problem Solving Method) moderately and 19.11 27.95 % students said that, the institute or Teachers use Student Centric Method (Experimental Learning, Participative Learning Problem Solving Method) to a somewhat extent.

- 26.48 % students are strongly agree that teachers encourage students to participate in extra-curricular activities, 69.11 % students are agreed that teachers encourage students to participate in extra-curricular activities, 02.94 % students are neutral on their opinion and 01.47 % students are disagreed with that, teachers encourage students to participate in extra-curricular activities,
- According to data, 29.42 % students given their opinion that, efforts made by Institute/teachers to inculcate Soft Skills, Life Skills and Employability Skills to a great extent, the opinion of 42.64 % said that, Efforts made by Institute/teachers to inculcate Soft Skills, Life Skills and Employability Skills moderately, 25% students opinioned that, Efforts made by Institute/teachers to inculcate Soft Skills, Life Skills and Employability Skills on somewhat extent and only 02.94 % students opinioned that Efforts made by Institute/teachers to inculcate Soft Skills, Life Skills and Employability Skills on vbery little extent.
- 02.95 % students told that, up to 90 % teachers are using ICT tools i.e. LCD projector, multimedia etc. within their teaching, 25 % students opinioned that, between 70 to 89 percent teachers are using ICT tools i.e. LCD projector, multimedia etc. within their teaching, 22.05 % students told that, approximately 50 to 69 % teachers are using ICT tools i.e. LCD projector, multimedia etc. within their teaching, and mostly 50% students opinioned that the percentage of using ICT tools (LCD, Multimedia etc.) by the teachers within their teaching-learning process between 30 to 49.
- 23.53 % students are strongly agreed that, Efforts made by Institute/teachers to inculcate Soft Skills, Life Skills and Employability Skills, 60.30 % students agreed that, Efforts made by Institute/teachers to inculcate Soft Skills, Life Skills and Employability Skills, 13.23 % students stick on neutral opinion, 02.95 % students disagree with the said opinion.
- Following suggestions/observations made by the students regarding to improve teaching-learning on preferential basis:
  1. Sr. Teachers prepared well before teaching.
  2. Very few Teachers use ITC tools occasionally.
  3. Each teacher should provide Notes.
  4. Group discussion method should be use mostly.
  5. Literature related to social work syllabus should provide in Marathi Medium.
  6. To promote a participative approach in teaching-learning process.
  7. Internal evaluation should be kept without any bias & prejudiced.
  8. Students should train in making PPT & its presentation.
  9. Developed interview skills among the students.
  10. In T-L process, skills lab session to be organize occasionally.
  11. Relevant books & references.
  12. Some teachers very weak in communication process.
  13. Class rooms should be made smart with LCD projector, white board, sound system etc.
  14. Made special teaching arrangement to those students whose offer English medium.

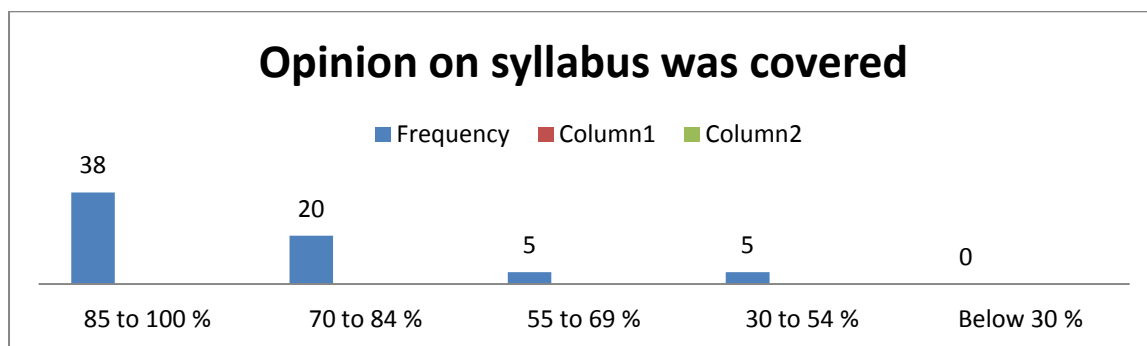
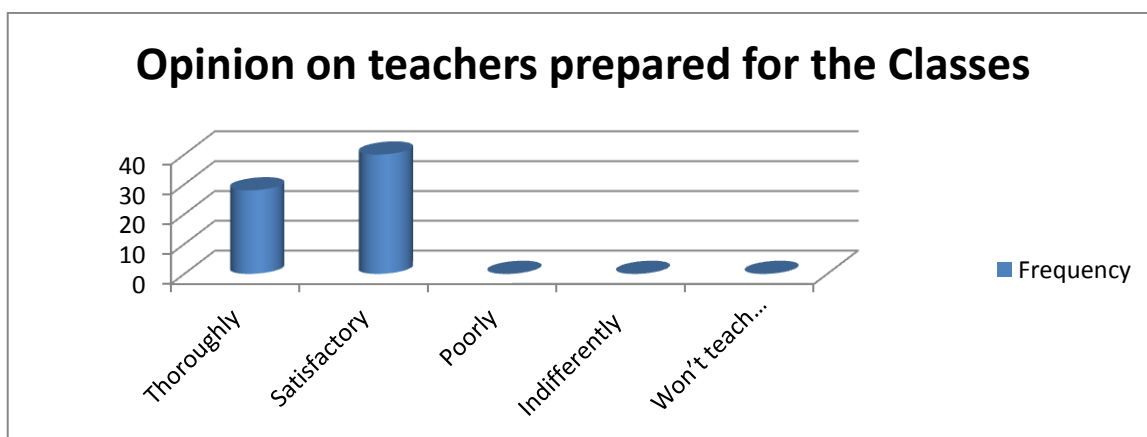

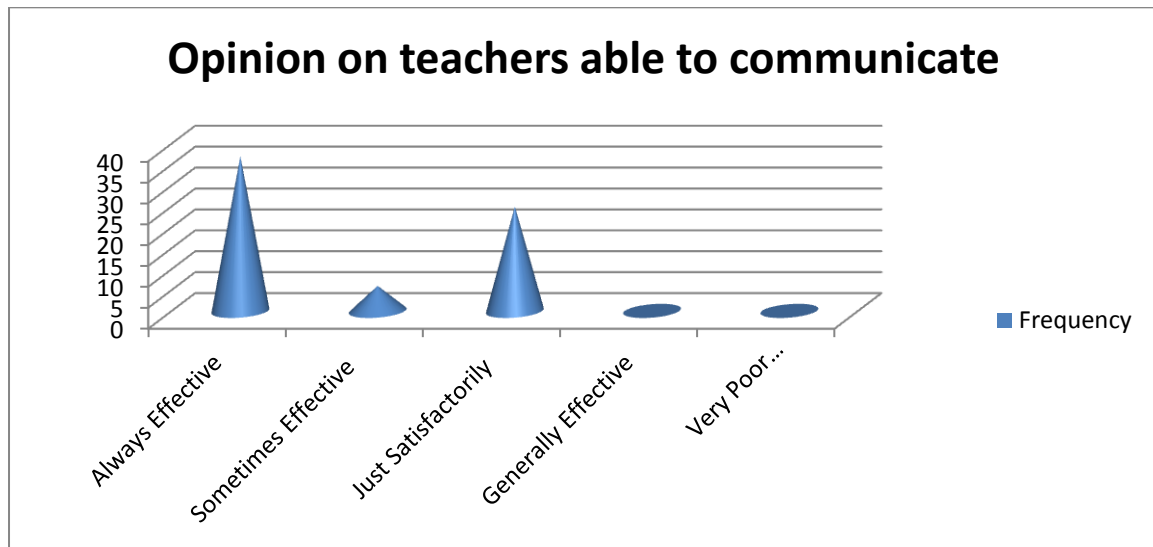

**Opinion on teachers able to communicate**

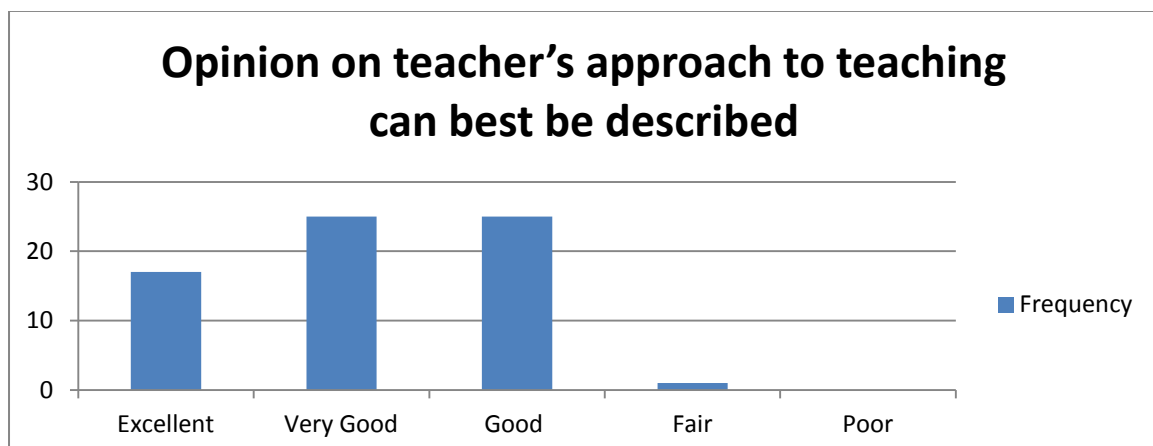

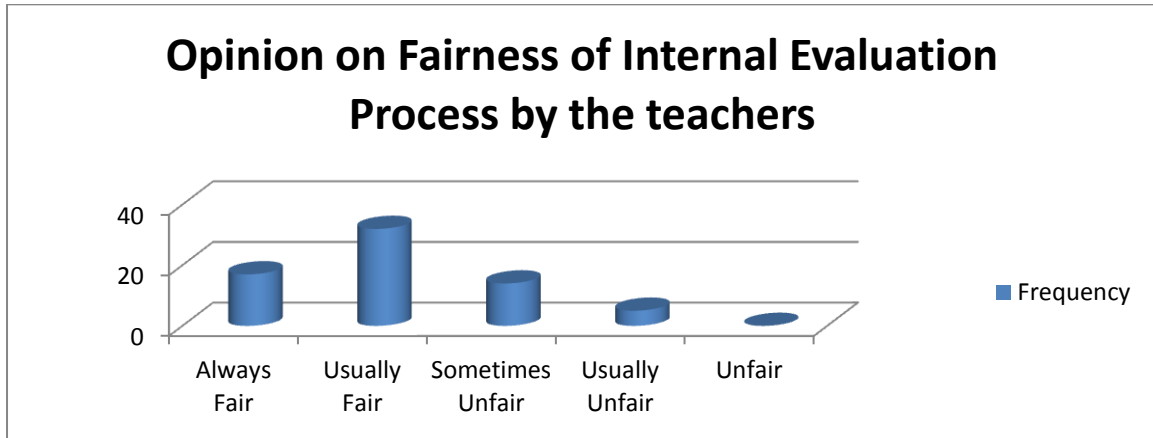

**Opinion on Fairness of Internal Evaluation Process by the teachers**

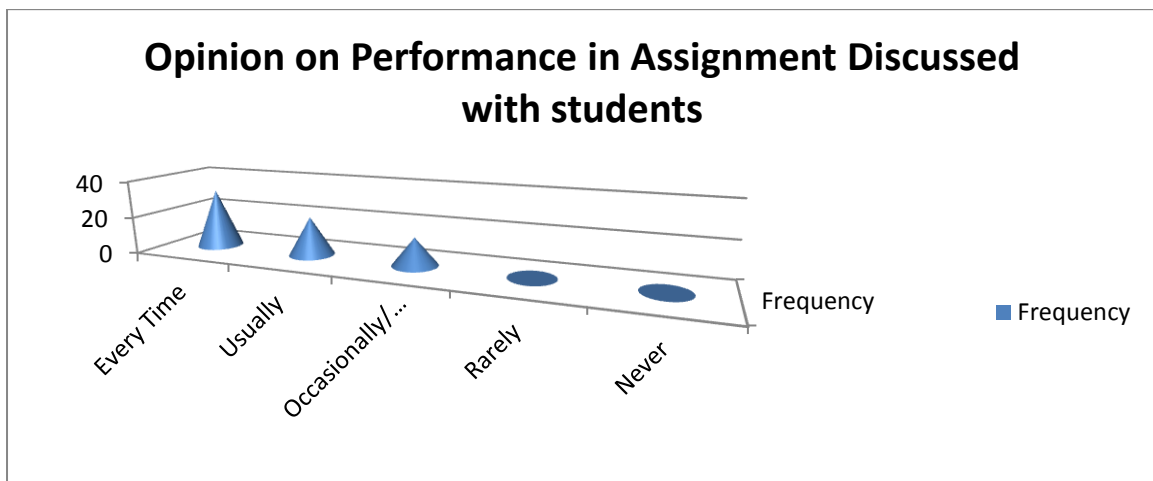

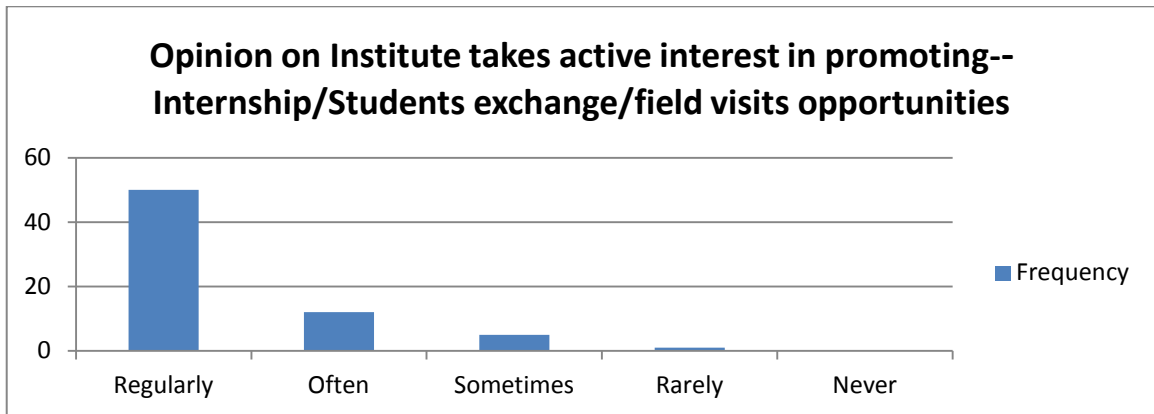

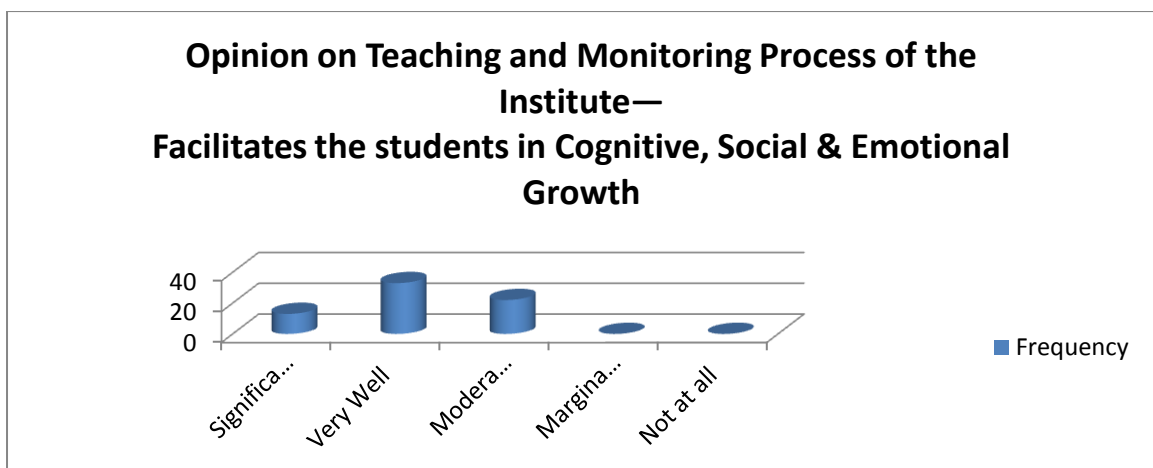

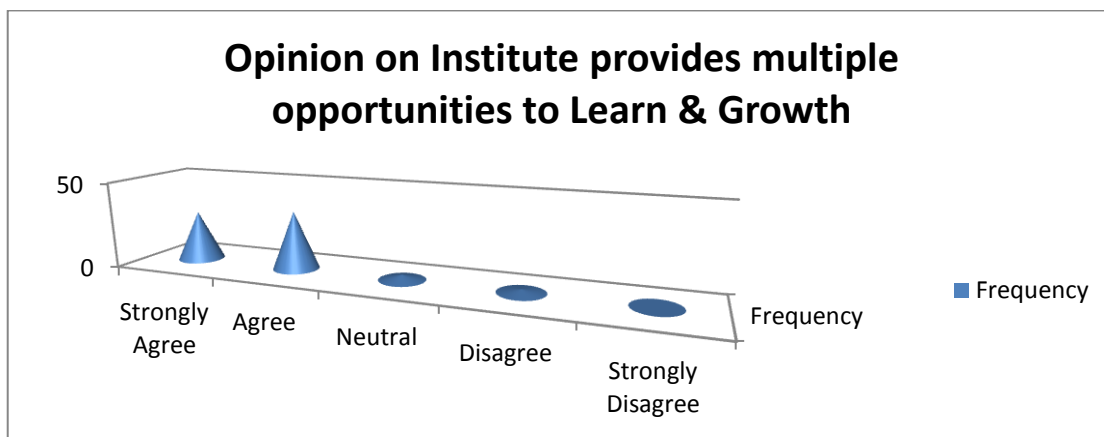

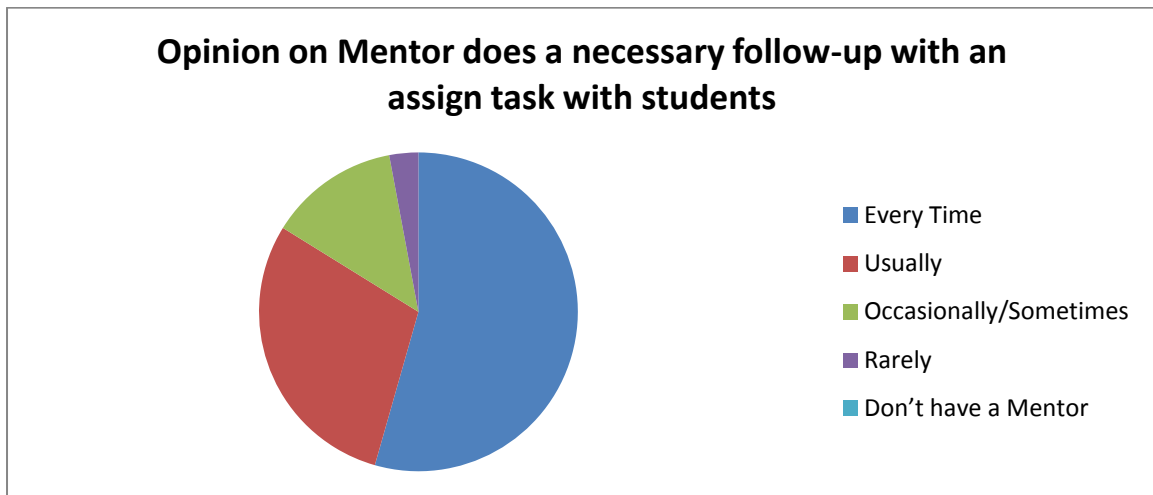

**Opinion on Mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assign task with students**

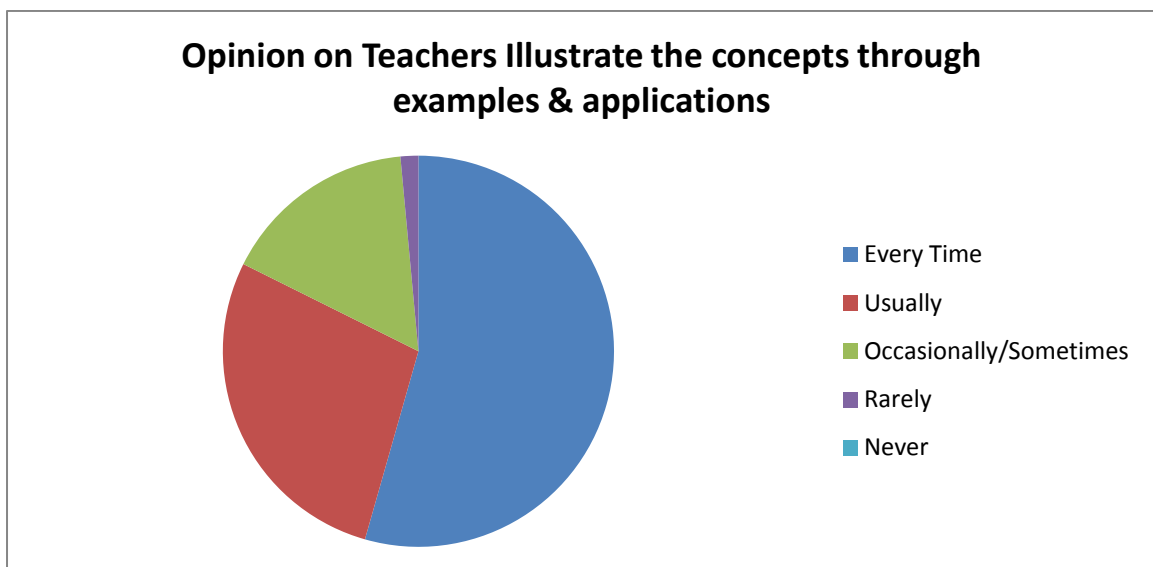

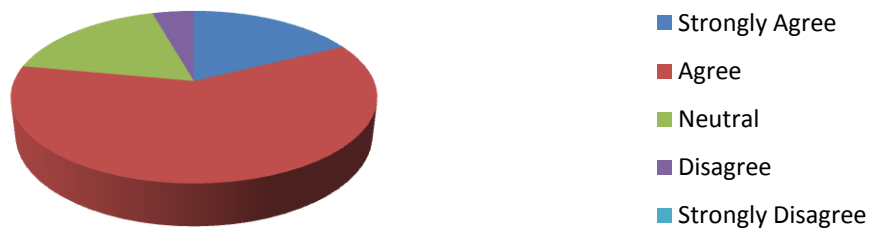

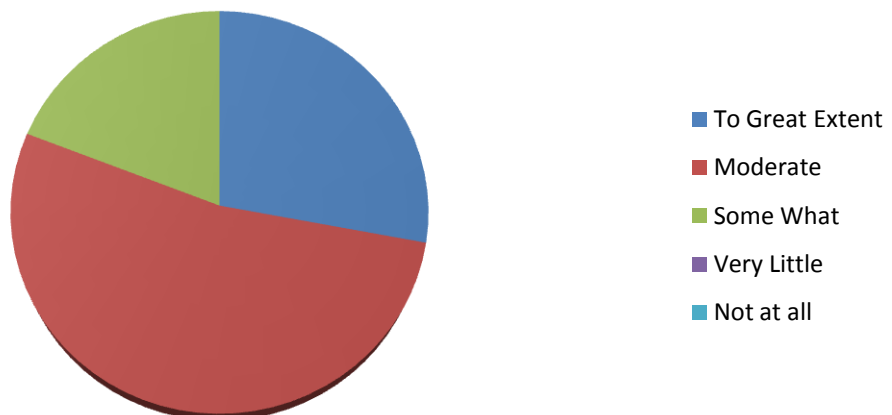

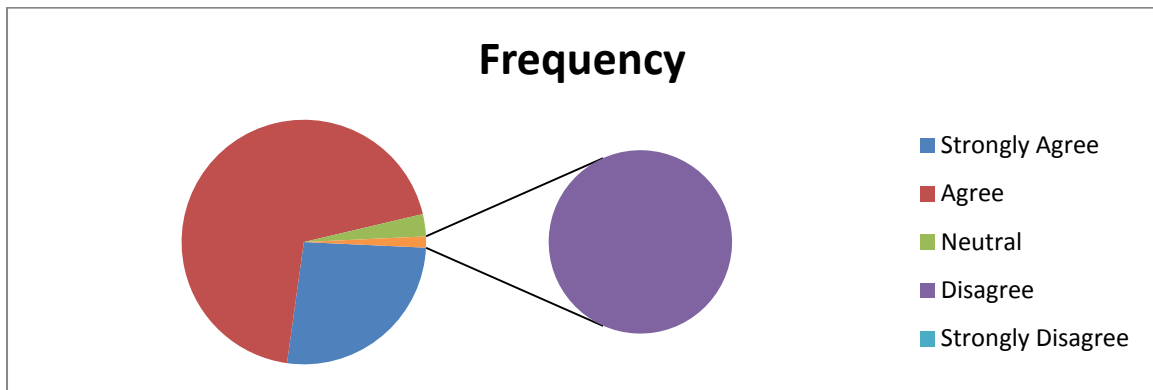

**Opinion about teachers encourage students to participate in extra-curricular activities**

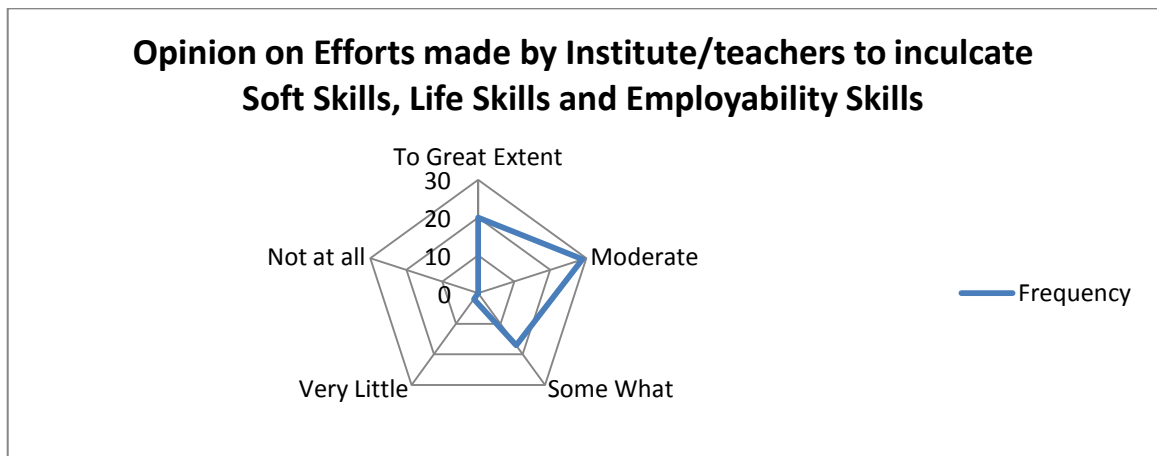

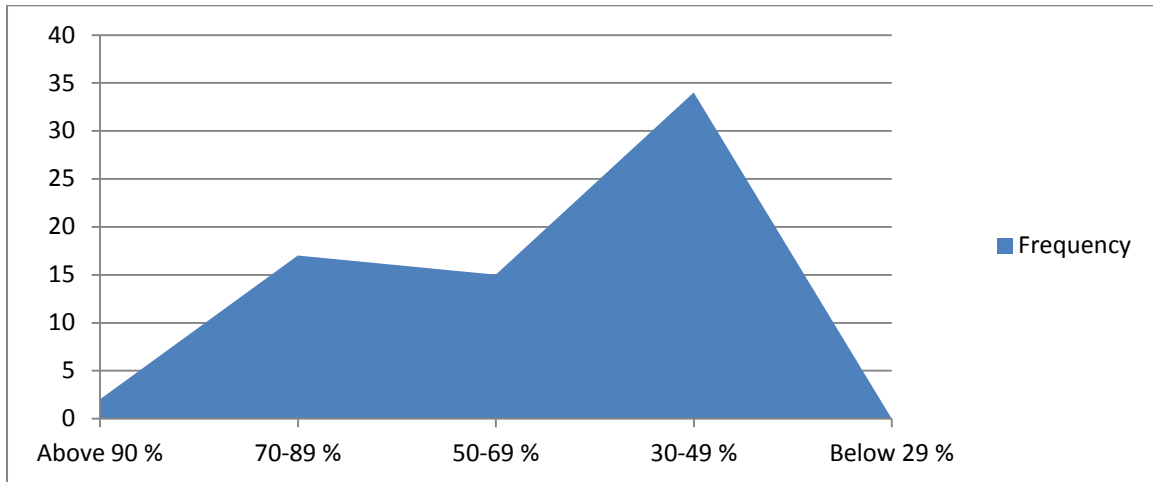

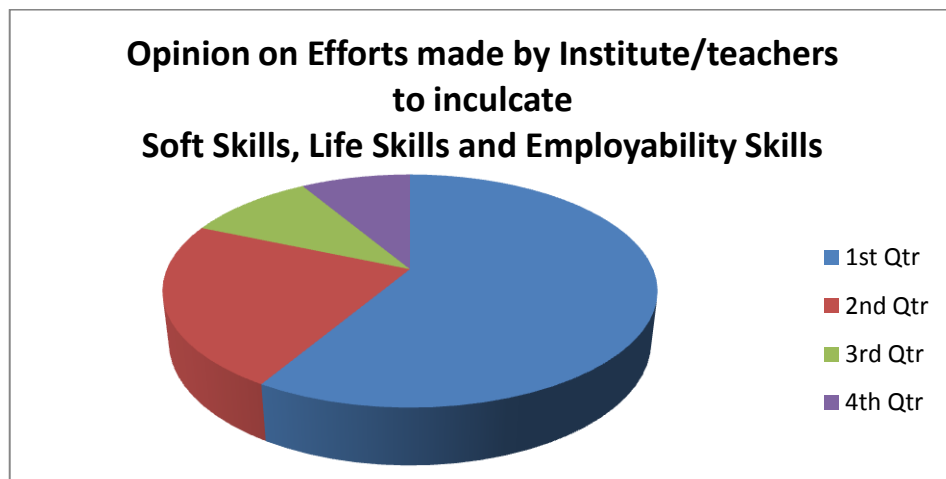
