Feedback of Students on curriculum and other aspects 2019-2020

The specially constituted committee for the purpose analyzed the feedback collected from the students. Total **153** students participated in the survey. Undergraduate and post graduate level students participated in the survey. The survey was conducted in the month of February 2020. The feedback was concern with the present syllabus, curriculum and other academic aspects. The feedback reveals major findings which are important for further planning. Although the institute has meager role to play in designing of syllabus, curriculum and other academic activities as this is the work allotted to RTM Nagpur University. But, one teacher of the institute represent BOS in social work. During the staff meetings and informal discussion, opinion on various aspects are expressed by the teachers and then conveyed to the members of the BOS. The survey indicates that as regards to design of course curriculum 26 % of students opinioned that it is excellent while 40 % of them said it is good and 28 % said that is average and remaining 6 % of them said that it is poor. This data clearly shows that the students have varied opinion on the question. As regards to the statement "Depth of Topic covered in the syllabus" the students have responded in four point scale as excellent = 20 %, Good 28 %, Average = 44% and poor 08%. The data indicates that there is a need of improvement in this aspect of syllabus.


The statement regarding "Periodical updating of the syllabus are intone with recent trends in the field" the students responded as excellent = 24 %, good= 18 %, Average= 30 % and Poor= 28 %. As regards to the opinion of students on the statement "Learning Value's" they responded in this manner. 39 % of them opinioned that it is excellent while only 8 % opinioned that it is poor. The students expressed their opinion on the statement "Employability is given focus in the curriculum design" 42 % of them excellent and good, while remaining 58 % opinioned average and poor. This finding needs intervention from the authorities of the college in jobs generation for them. Similarly teaching faculty and placement committee is required to take note of this finding. The statement made in the feed-back form no. 6 which says "Emphasis on the practical/project internship in the course contents" the students indicated that 24 % said excellent, 22 % said it is good, 46 % as average and only 8 % of them said that is poor.


Regarding opinion on the statement made in the feedback format "relevance of Text and Reference books with the Curriculum" they responded as – excellent= 30 %, 24 % good, 18 % average and remaining 28 % said that it is poor. The statement "Course Contents enhance situational competence" the 72 % students responded is positive while remaining 28 % students responded in negative manner. The statement was made in the format by which we wanted to know their opinion on "Whether there is value based inclusion in the syllabus". 48 % of them expressed in affirmative while remaining 52 % in negative manner. The important statement included in the present survey which says " scope of extra learning and self study in the course content" data shows that sixty six percent of students are of the opinion that definitely there is a scope while remaining thirty four are of the opinion that there is no scope.

Regarding the opinion on "The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow." out of 153 students, 46 % of students opined excellent, 48 % opinioned good, 8% students opined average and remaining 2 % had opined poor. Regarding opinion on the statement made in the feedback format "The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications." they responded as – excellent= 44 %, 46 % good, 08 % average and remaining 02% said that poor. The important statement included in the present survey which says "The teachers identify strengths and encourage with providing right level of challenges." data shows that fifty eight percent of students are of the opinion that "excellent", eighteen percent "good", fourteen percent said "average" and remaining twelve percent said that "poor". The statement regarding "Teachers are able to identify weaknesses and help to overcome them." the students responded as excellent = 28 %, good = 12 %, average = 36 % and poor = 24 %. The statement regarding "Teachers encourage to participate in extracurricular activities." the students responded as to - "excellent" = 38 %, "good" = 24 %, "average" = 34 % and "poor" = 8 %.

The students were asked to give suggestions on the curriculum. This question was open ended. Only 68 % students have opined on this question and remaining 32% of them had no suggestions at all and hence they preferred to not to response to this question. The common suggestions are listed below with the percentage of response (out of 68 % students).

- Teacher should focus on online teaching and prepared the students for the online learning experience.
- Course syllabus should be flexible and post the course syllabus on the college WEB
- New books and learning aids should purchased and administer a learning style inventory.
- Teacher should focus on general learning goals or objectives.
- Notes should be provided to students by concern subject teachers.

Feedback of Students on curriculum and other aspects 2020-2021

The specially constituted committee for the purpose analyzed the feedback collected from the students. Total 171 students participated in the survey. Undergraduate 50.3% and post graduate level 49.7% and 66.1% girls and 33.9 % boys' students participated in the survey. The survey was conducted in the month of February 2020. The feedback was concern with the present syllabus, curriculum and other academic aspects. The feedback reveals major findings which are important for further planning. Although the institute has meager role to play in designing of syllabus, curriculum and other academic activities as this is the work allotted to RTM Nagpur University. But, one teacher of the institute represents BOS in social work. During the staff meetings and informal discussion, opinion on various aspects are expressed by the teachers and then conveyed to the members of the BOS. How much course complete by the teachers 41.5 % of students opinioned that 85 to 100% covered, 35.1% of them said 70 to 84 % covered and 17.5% said 55 to 69% covered. The survey indicates that as regards to design of course curriculum 41.5 % of students opinioned that it is excellent while 32.2 % of them said it is good and 22 % said that is average and remaining 2 % of them said that it is poor. This data clearly shows that the students have varied opinion on the question. As regards to the statement "Depth of Topic covered in the syllabus" the students have responded in four point scale as excellent = 2.8 %, Good 73.7 %, Average = 17.5% and poor 6%. The data indicates that there is a need of improvement in this aspect of syllabus.

The statement regarding "Periodical updating of the syllabus are intone with recent trends in the field" the students responded as excellent = 41.5 %, good= 35.1 %, Average= 17.5 % and Poor= 5.9 %. As regards to the opinion of students on the statement "Learning Value's" they responded in this manner. 64.3 % of them opinioned that it is excellent while only 1 % opinioned that it is poor. The students expressed their opinion on the statement "Employability is given focus in the curriculum design" 80.7 % of them excellent and good, while remaining 19.3 % opinioned average and poor. This finding needs intervention from the authorities of the college in jobs generation for them. Similarly teaching faculty and placement committee is required to take note of this finding. The statement made in the feed-back form no. 6 which says "Emphasis on the practical/project internship in the course contents" the students indicated that 22.8 % said excellent, 31.6 % said it is good, 23.4 % as average and 22.2 % of them said that is poor.


Regarding opinion on the statement made in the feedback format "relevance of Text and Reference books with the Curriculum" they responded as – excellent= 53.8 %, 38 % good, 6 % average and remaining 2.2 % said that it is poor. The statement "Course Contents enhance situational competence" the 91.8 % students responded is positive while remaining 8.2 % students responded in negative manner. The statement was made in the format by which we wanted to know their opinion on "Whether there is value based inclusion in the syllabus". 91.3 % of them expressed in affirmative while remaining 8.7 % in negative manner. The important statement included in the present survey which says "scope of extra learning and self study in


the course content" data shows that 92.9 percent of students are of the opinion that definitely there is a scope while remaining 7.1% are of the opinion that there is no scope.

Regarding the opinion on "The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow." out of 171 students, 57.3 % of students opined excellent, 28.1 % opinioned good, 12.3% students opined average and remaining 2 % had opined poor. Regarding opinion on the statement made in the feedback format "The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications." they responded as – excellent= 55.6 %, 25.7 % good, 11.1 % average and remaining 7.6% said that poor. The important statement included in the present survey which says "The teachers identify strengths and encourage with providing right level of challenges." data shows that 35.1 percent of students are of the opinion that "excellent", 46.2 percent "good", fourteen percent said "average" and remaining 4.7 percent said that "poor". The statement regarding "Teachers are able to identify weaknesses and help to overcome them." the students responded as excellent = 74.6%, good = 20.7 %, average = 4.7 % and no one had opined poor. The statement regarding "Teachers encourage to participate in extracurricular activities." the students responded as to - "excellent" = 53.3 %, "good" = 40.2 %, "average" = 6.5 % and no one had opined poor.

The students were asked to give suggestions on the curriculum. This question was open ended. Only 82 % students have opined on this question and remaining 28% of them had no suggestions at all and hence they preferred to not to response to this question. The common suggestions are listed below with the percentage of response (out of 82 % students).

- Teacher should focus on online teaching and prepared the students for the online learning experience.
- Course syllabus should be flexible and post the course syllabus on the college WEB
- New books and learning aids should purchased and administer a learning style inventory.
- Teacher should focus on general learning goals or objectives.
- Notes should be provided to students by concern subject teachers.
